Robert Gregory "Bob" Johnston, 64, of Hohenwald, TN, went to be with our Lord and Savior on Saturday, August 11, 2018 while doing what he loved, riding his Harley. Born on November 5th, 1953, He served Lewis County in many ways, although he was greatest known for his 20 year tenure as Tax Assessor during which he was voted Tax Assessor of the Year in the State of Tennessee. Bob served honorably in the Vietnam War. He was a past President of the Lewis County Jaycees, Chairman of the South Central Area Fair Board, a Mason, a member of the American Legion, and former chain gang for the Lewis County Panthers. Bob was always available to give sound advice with a smile and stiff pat on the back. Known to his family as a loving husband, father, "Pop", constant tinkerer, and jack of all trades, except when it comes to plumbing, he lived a boisterous life. He is preceded in death by daughter Delaney Johnston and mother Lola Whitworth. 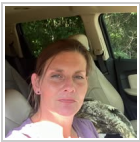

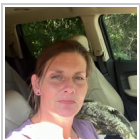

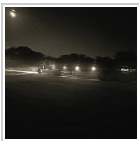
