



Clinnon Wayne Alexander

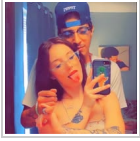
January 16, 1960 - August 26, 2020

At this time, no services are scheduled for Mr. Alexander.

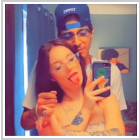

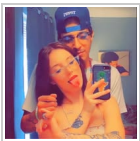

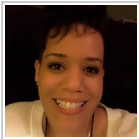
