Diane Graham, age 78, of Hohenwald, Tennessee, passed away on May 3, 2026.

She was born on October 4, 1947, in Natchez, Mississippi, to the late Percy Arnold and Fannie Huber Arnold. Diane was proud of her upbringing and heritage, raised in a strong Christian home with deep roots in faith. Her father and other family members were preachers, and she often spoke with pride of her grandmother's Native American heritage.
