Fred was an entrepreneur, for many years Fred brought entertainment to his establishment Fred's and then built another establishment naming it Fred's Disco. People would come from surrounding cities every weekend to enjoy a night on the Town and that Town was called "Wrigley". He often kept a packed house. When Fred talked about his establishment, he would always say "The Place", that's how he related to his business when conversing with other people. You could always tell that he was proud of his accomplishments.

Fred loved to go fishing, hunting, eating and he loved watching the Tennessee Vols Football Team Play. He was a die-hard Fan of Tennessee. Fred would not leave his home without his University of Tennessee attire. He loved UT so

much that he painted his Birdhouse and Shed with the Tennessee color orange.
