Mr. Glen Everett Ammons, age 96, passed away from this home to his eternal home, on Friday, August 7, 2020, exactly one month after the loss of his beloved wife and best friend of 71 years Mrs. Bettye Ammons.

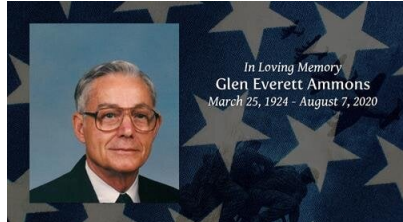
