He was a dedicated member of the Centerville Church of Christ. He married his high school sweetheart, Sarah Joyce Hann December 1, 1957 and were married almost 62 years. He was drafted into the Army and stationed in Germany for 2 years. He was an Expert (Mortar 4.2mm) and Expert (Rifle M-1). He returned to Hickman County where he worked in the maintenance departments of Genesco, Tenncon/Signage/Plastiline.
