Imogean Warren, born July 19, 1939, to the late James Shelt Mercer and Nora Bryson Mercer, passed away on October 29, 2024, at 85 years old. Originally from Perry County, TN, she attended a one-room schoolhouse on Coon Creek before moving with her family to Detroit at age 12, where she spent much of her life before returning to Hohenwald, TN. Imogean began her career washing dishes at the Swan View Restaurant, later becoming a cook. A proud achievement in her life was earning her GED at 50.

Imogean loved bringing family together, especially at Thanksgiving and Christmas, where her chocolate and pecan pies, baked ham, and cakes were cherished. She was a talented seamstress, learning to quilt on her own and enjoying painting, gardening, board games, and reading. She also had a lifelong love for dancing, especially "The Twist," and enjoyed trips to Gatlinburg and watching birds. Of the Mormon faith at her passing, she also attended the Blondy Church of God.
