Imogene Rasbury Parsley, age 92 of Oak Ridge, Tennessee passed away November 23, 2018. Jean, as she was known to all, was born in Kutch Hollow, Wayne County, Tennessee to Clyde and Marie Graves Rasbury. After growing up and attending school in Wayne County, Jean graduated from Martin Methodist Junior College and from Tennessee Tech with a BS in mathematics. The good life for Jean included lots of time with her two sisters. They took many trips together across the US and to Europe.
