Jacky Wayne Gilmer, 78, of Lobelville, TN, died Sunday, August 28, 2016, at Vanderbilt University Medical Center, Nashville, TN, surrounded by his family. Wayne was born to the late Jack and Inez (Byrd) Gilmer on October 31, 1937, at his family homeplace in Gilmer Hollow near Lobelville. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his grandparents, S.N. and Martha Ann (Ledbetter) Gilmer and Joe and Etta (Patton) Byrd, all of Perry County, TN. Wayne graduated from Lobelville High School and served in the Tennessee Air National Guard. He spent most of his career with the state of Tennessee and retired as Chief Engineer for WLJT-TV, Lexington/Martin, TN.

-Go south about eight miles, and you will pass Heath's Canoe Rental on your left.

-Then, turn left at the next road, Gilmer Bridge Road. (The road angles back sharply to the left. If -you go into the city of Lobelville, you have gone too far.)

-Drive across the bridge, and then turn right on Russell's Creek Road.

-After a bend in the road, you will come to a blacktop drive on your right. This is the road to the Gilmer Cemetery. (It is easy to miss. If you come to a fork in the road, you have gone too far.)

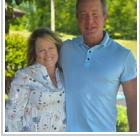
