Jedidiah "Jed" Addison Crews was born on April 4th, 1986 to Roy and Bonnie Crews. Born and raised in Centerville, Jed attended the University of Virginia on a Navy scholarship and graduated with degrees in foreign affairs and religious studies. After college, he served 4 years in the Navy, during which he married fellow Naval officer, Arlene Valenzuela. He left the Navy to move to Europe in support of Arlene's Navy assignment.
