Jeff was born on December 20, 1977, to Freddie Dean Kelsey and Carol Ann Spears, in Linden, TN.

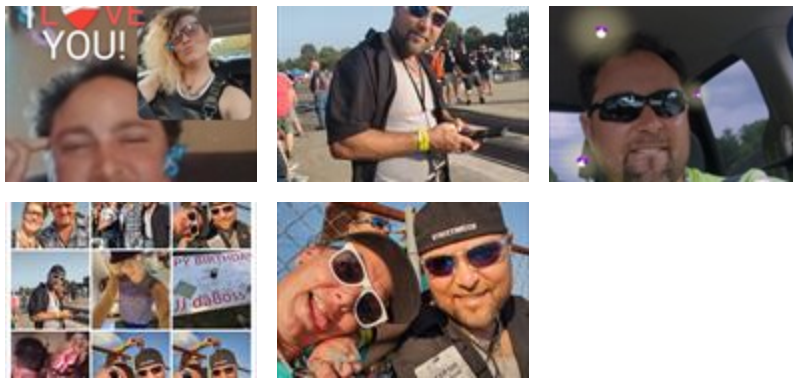
