



Johnny Edward Hooten

November 24, 1949 - December 15, 2018

Johnny Edward "John Ed" Hooten died in his home on Dec. 15, 2018, making his life here 69 years and 21 days. He worked for the company Union Carbide for nineteen years and worked as a meter reader for Heath Corp., an electric company, for roughly six years.

A visitation with the Hooten family will be held on Tuesday, December 18th, from 4:00 PM - 8:00 PM in the McDonald Funeral Home chapel. A funeral service for Johnny Edward Hooten will take place the following day, December 19th, at 2:00 PM. Burial will follow at the Stand Cemetery.

A native of Maury County, Johnny Edward Hooten was born on November 24, 1949 to the late Dozier and Roberta Morrow Hooten. While attending Hickman County High School, he was an outstanding baseball player and athlete. His love for the game extended late into his life as he continued to play softball until he was 46 years old, winning one state champion as an adult. He attended one year at the University of Tennessee at Martin and later received an Associates Degree from Columbia State Community College.

Johnny Edward is survived by his wife, Ann Allen Hooten, who he married on Christmas Day in 1970; daughters, Stacey Hooten and Cori Parks; four grandchildren, Preslie Baker, Reagan Baker, Sierra Seeback and AJ Seeback; brother, Ron (Lexa) Hooten; and a host of other family and friends.
