Mandy was diagnosed with Cystic Fibrosis at birth and received a double lung transplant in 2000., made possible in part by the generous donations of the kind people of Hickman &

Dickson County, TN, and St. Clair County, MI. She loved reading, swimming, fishing, the Piney River, kayaking, traveling, shopping, and, especially her 4 furbabies she also loved the theater Mandy was often described as a social butterfly, she made everyone feel important.

The funeral will be on Saturday, December 1, 2018, at 1 pm it has been entrusted to McDonald Funeral Home, 102 West End Ave, Centerville, TN 37033. 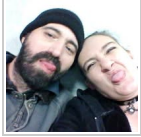
