Minnie Sue Totty Baker, age 95, passed away on December 26, 2015 at Green Hills Health and Rehabilitation in Nashville. Services will be conducted at 11:00 o'clock on Tuesday, December 29, 2015 in the chapel of McDonald Funeral Home in Centerville with Bill McDonald and Glenn Richardson officiating.
