Roger Wayne Vaughn was born April 13, 1950, in Wrigley, Tennessee to the late Grover Cleveland and Nola Cotham Vaughn, and died on August 31, 2021, in Franklin, Tennessee, at the age of 71.

He was a US Army veteran that served in the Vietnam War. He worked as a contractor in the Franklin, Tennessee area from the 1970s to the 1990s. He was known for building homes the right way and took his time. He would drive a nail in two hits every time.

When Roger was younger he enjoyed messing with old cars. He last owned a '68 Chevelle. He loved watching races and sports. He oftentimes would stay on the phone with his brother Paul through an entire broadcast commentating on whatever event they happened to be watching.

He was married to Diane Vaughn for 42 years. Although the two had gone their separate ways Diane was there to make sure he and Andrew were taken care of.
