



## William Hadley Mangrum

May 4, 1931 - July 31, 2025

William "Hadley" Mangrum, of Pinewood, Tennessee, worked hard, loved well and never passed up a good story or a Friday night football game. On July 31, 2025, surrounded by his family, he passed peacefully at the age of 94. Hadley was born in Dickson County, Tennessee, to the late Caleb Owen "Dick" and Hannah Sullivan Mangrum.

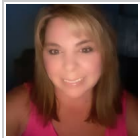

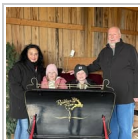
