Mr. William Rodgers a resident of Hampshire, TN, age 90 passed away on Friday, January 11th at the LifeCare Center of Centerville. He was born February 20th, 1928 to the late James Emmett Rodgers & Annie Ava (Rodgers) Sisco in Pleasantville, TN. He served 20+ years with the Air Force, serving from 1948 - 1968 during the Korean and Vietnam Wars, during his time with the Air Force he obtained the rank of Chief Master Sergeant, the highest enlisted rank in the Air Force. After returning home he worked for the United States Postal Service for many years as a mail carrier.
